This past year has been exciting for GBAPP celebrating our 30th year as a community-based organization that has touched the lives of thousands of youth and families in our community.

This year, we were especially proud of the fact that GBAPP's logo and official name has been recast to reflect the expanded role of the organization. The organization's legal name is being changed from the Greater Bridgeport Adolescent Pregnancy Program, Incorporated, to GBAPP, Inc. Under the new name, GBAPP stands for the Greater Bridgeport Area Prevention Program, with the tag line: Building a Healthier Community through Education, Collaboration and Intervention.

For the last thirty years, GBAPP has been first in developing and implementing new initiatives: school-based health clinics, teen fathers program, life choices after-school program, health educator team, supportive housing programs for pregnant, parenting, and single girls, community based life skills education, case management services for DCF kids moving into permanent housing, HIV prevention programs for youth, faith-based organizations, women and their partners, and college students, NIA Alliance, a cadre of community women trained to offer HIV and substance abuse education, and many more prevention and early intervention programs in the greater Bridgeport area.

Over the last thirty years GBAPP has proudly served thousands and thousands of teens and adults in our region. With your continued support we look forward to another thirty years bringing our community cutting edge programs to serve the needs of our clients. Thank you all for your support.

At a glance...

In 2010, GBAPP provided a number of essential services in our community and achieved our agency goals with the following major accomplishments.

- Federal grant awarded by Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration/ Center for Substance Abuse Prevention in the amount of \$300,000/year for five years from CSAP for the Odyssey Project, a substance abuse and HIV prevention program for college aged young people ages 18-24; partnership with the University of Bridgeport.
- Completed major construction project—enclosed the porch area at Housing for Success to expand administrative and training space.
- The NIA Alliance, a group of community women trained to provide counseling and testing for at-risk individuals in Bridgeport. The first in the state with DPH authorization.
- Decreased teen births at Harding from 64 live births to enrolled students to 14 in two years. Provided evidence-based human sexuality education at Harding utilizing community health educators and interns.
- GBAPP Teen Fathers Program received Certification by CT Department of Social Services --- the only teen dads program to receive state certification.
- The Bridgeport Superintendent of schools selected GBAPP to act as lead agency and fiduciary for the Central High School Leadership Team, a substance abuse prevention, treatment and recovery program.
- Successful 30th Anniversary Dinner with the Three Doctors attending, bringing 400 kids for the Assembly at Central High School and an additional 250 people to the dinner celebration.
- Officially changed organizational name to GBAPP, Inc. from the Greater Bridgeport Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Program. Revised logo, letter-head, business cards, etc.
